Chronic diseases include: Malignant neoplasm of stomach, Malignant neoplasms of colon, rectum and anus, Malignant neoplasm of pancreas, Malignant neoplasms of trachea, bronchus and lung, Malignant neoplasm of breast, Malignant neoplasms of cervix uteri, corpus uteri and ovary, Malignant neoplasm of prostate, Malignant neoplasms of urinary tract, Non-Hodgkin's lymphoma, Leukemia, Other malignant neoplasms, Diabetes mellitus, Alzheimer's disease, Hypertensive heart disease with or without renal disease, Ischemic heart diseases, Other diseases of heart, Essential (primary) hypertension and hypertensive renal disease, Cerebrovascular diseases, Atherosclerosis, Other diseases of circulatory system, Chronic lower respiratory diseases, Peptic ulcer, Chronic liver disease and cirrhosis, Nephritis, nephrotic syndrome and nephrosis
